What is Colorwalk?

- Colorwalk is an outdoor hike along the historic I&M Canal which is also known as the Chief Shabbona Trail.
- Colorwalk is an excellent opportunity for scouts to learn skills for rank advancements, activity pins, belt loops, and merit badges for scouts of all ages in addition to enjoy the outdoors

Who is Colorwalk For?

- Colorwalk is for EVERYONE!!!
- Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, Venturers, Girl Scouts and their family and friends are all welcome and will find something to interest them!

Cub Scouts: What do we have to offer?

- There will be several activities and attractions catering to your Cub Scouts needs such as the skill stations for Axe yard (Knife Skills), Fire Building, Knot tying, and Orienteering (Map and Compass)
- Lists of requirements for activity pins and belt loops will be available in advance that can be easily earned through Colorwalk
- There are several hike lengths to suit the needs of your boys you can do a short hike, a 5mile, or 10 mile hike

Boy Scouts: What is there to do ?

- Totally new programs
- Skill stations that will help you scouts work towards their next ranks in areas such as : Axe Yard, Fire Building, Knot Tying, Orienteering (Map and Compass)
- Multiple hike lengths to fulfill requirements for both rank advancement and merit badges. Hike Lengths offered are:
 - 10 miles/20 miles – For Hiking Merit Badge
 - 15 miles on a bike – For Camping Merit Badge

Please bring your own bikes and helmets **MUST** be worn at all times

What are these skills stations ?

- Skill stations situated along the trail will be short lessons in specific scout essential areas
- 10-15 minute lessons
- Lessons will be tailored around advancement requirements for Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts

How do I Sign up?

- Register with your den, pack or troop
- Pre-registration and Pre- Payment is strongly recommended as a unit
- However, walk ups are welcome on the day of the event as we would like every scout to have the opportunity to attend

How much does it cost?

- Colorwalk is \$5.00 which includes a patch and use of all offered program areas
- Please bring money to spend at the concession stands as there will be a large selection of items for sale
